Appointing Board to report estimated assessments to paythe cost and expense of certain improvements in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by council to assess the whole cost of constructing and installing a system for lighting Stanwood Poad between Broad Street and Maryland Avenue, except one-fiftieth (1/50th) thereof, and the cost of intersections, as described in Ordinance No. '965, passed September 25, 1928, NOW, THEREFORE!

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That Walter E. Ludwig, C. R. Carrick and John Dunnink, three disinterested freeholders of said Village be, and they are hereby, appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the respective ordinances or resolutions determining to proceed with said improvements in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said improvements to the several lots and parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council said estimated assessment.
