RESOLUTION NO. 771.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That sidewalks shall be constructed on both sides of Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Mound Street to the South terminus of said street, of the character and in the manner following: Said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by Council and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk; it shall be five (5) feet in width with a cross slope of 3/8ths of an inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 131 feet from the back edge of the curb. The grade of the inside edge, or edge next to the lot line, shall be five and one-half $(5\frac{1}{2})$ inches above the curb, and parallel thereto.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

That the Clerk of Council be, and he is hereby, directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this Resolution to be served as required by law.
