RESOLUTION NO. 774.

To provide for the purchase of one automobile truck.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
BENLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village purchase an automobile truck of one and one-half ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ ) ton capacity, same to be equipped with express body, automatic windshield wiper, with extra rim or wheel and front bumper, and to be of make listing under One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).


Section 2. That there be and hereby is appropriated for said purpose the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Safety Fund.


Section 3. That the clerk be and hereby is authorized to advertise for the purchase of said automobile truck according to law.
