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RESOLUTION NO. 781.

Appointing board to report estimated assessments to pay the cost and expense of certain improvements in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess that part of the cost hereinafter designated of those certain improvements set forth in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvements, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY,
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Walter E. Ludwig, Jm. Schneider and Charles L. Crippen, three disinterested free-holders of said Village be, and they are hereby, appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost and expenses on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the respective ordinances determining to proceed with said improvements in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said improvements to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council said estimated assessments, said improvements with said respective ordinances and proportion of cost to be assessed being as follows, to-wit:

Mound Street from College Avenue to LaClair Avenue, Ordinance No. 1004, passed April 23, 1929, the entire cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth thereof and the cost of intersections.

Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Mound Street to Main Street, Ordinance No. 1005, passed April 23, 1929, the entire cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections.


Park Hill Drive from Westland Avenue to Park Drive, Ordinance No. 969, passed Nov. 13, 1928, the entire cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
