
To accept bid of Harold M. Bright for constructing a sanitary sewer in the alley east of Chelsea Avenue, Gould Road and the extension thereof.




To accept bid of Central City Construction Company for the construction of water mains in portions of Maryland Avenue, Gould Road, Main Street and Mound Street.


