## AN ORDINANCE NO. 986.

To levy special assessments for the construction of sidewalks on Columbia Avenue from Bryden Road to Broad Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing sidewalks on each side of Columbia Avenue from Bryden Road to Broad Street in the Village of Bexley, pursuant to a Resolution No. 736, adopted August 28th, 1928, ordering said improvement to be made, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars, (\$900.00), as reported to the Council by the Village Engineers on the \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of January, 1929, notice of filing of which report and the assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby, approved, adopted and confirmed and that there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessment, together with the description of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefit.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in two annual installments, with interest at the rate of 43% per annum, from May 1st, 1929. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by

the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
