AN ORDINANCE NO. 993.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Elm Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Columbia Avenue and from Cassady Road to Remington Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Elm Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Columbia Avenue and from Cassady Road to Remington Road, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary sewers or drains to furnish proper drainage for said improvement and erecting street signs, also constructing sidewalks on both sides of said avenue from Cassady Road to Remington Road, pursuant to and in accordance with Ordinance No. 992, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by Council on the 28th day of February, 1928, in the aggregate amount of Ten Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars, (\$10,500.00), as reported to this Council on the 27th day of December, 1928, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:

lot or parcel of land shall be paid in each within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in nine annual installments, with interest at the rate of 4% per annum, from June 1st, 1929. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
