ORDINANCE NO. 995.

Accepting plat of "Catherine Ruhl's Subdivision", a subdivision in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, and accepting and confirming the grant and dedication of rights therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Catherine Ruhl's Subdivision, a subdivision in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, of all of Lot 22 and Lot 32 except 90 feet off the south side of said Lot 32, of the Subdivision of the Estate of Anton Ruhl, Deceased, as the same is shown of record in Plat Book 8, page 7-A, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohic; and also that vacated portion of Drexel Avenue, along the east side of the above described portion of lot 32, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted, and that the dedication and grant of rights to the public for the maintenance and repair of public utilities located within said addition legend the same are hereby approved, accepted and confirmed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
