ORDINANCE NO. 1037.

By Mr. Kerr.

To levy special assessments for the installation of a system of lighting for Columbia Avenue from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, and Mound Street from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing and installing a system of lighting for Columbia Avenue from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, and Mound Street from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue in the Village of Bexley, by laying underground cables, erecting iron light standards, installing lamps, conduits and other necessary equipment, pursuant to and in accordance with Ordinance No. 1013, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed June 11th, 1929, in the aggregate amount of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00), as reported to this council on the 21st. day of December, 1929, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:-

All assessments installments, thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Audit Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him p_ upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.
