ORDINANCE NO. 1039.

By Mr. Manly.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Mound Street from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue, in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Mound Street from College Avenue to Daclaire Avenue, in said Village, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, and constructing the necessary sewers or drains to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, installing water taps and necessary sanitary sanitary sewer taps, constructing side walks on both sides thereof and erecting street signs, pursuant to and inaccordance with Ordinance No. 1004, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by Council on the 23rd. day of April, 1929, in the aggregate amount of Twenty Five Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$25,200.00), as reported to this council on the 21st. day of December, 1929, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:
