AN ORDINANCE NO. 1054.

Determining to proceed with the construction of a main drain or sewer in the north side of Broad Street from Alum Creek to a point 600 feet easterly therefrom.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring.

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction of a main drain or sewer in the north side of Broad Street from Alum Creek to a point 600 feet easterly therefrom for the purpose of furnishing surface and storm drainage, in accordance with Resolution No. 833, passed on the 18th day of March, 1930, declaring the necessity for said improvement, and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk, and said sewer or drain shall be constructed of concrete pipe or segment block.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement, and the solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said improvement and demages awarded any owner of adjoining lands and interest thereon, and the costs and expenses of any such award, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds in the manner provided by law; and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys and of printing and publishing the notices, resolutions and ordinances required, and the serving of said notices, the cost of construction, and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 4. That the clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force of from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
