

ORDINANCE NO. 1056.

Providing for the regulating and licensing of haulers of refuse.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. No person shall engage in the business or occupation of hauling refuse or waste materials for hire on or over the highways within the Village of Bexley, without first having taken out a license for the same from the Mayor of the Village.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to grant a license to any person of good character upon the payment by such person into the Village Treasury of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), which license shall be good for the remainder of the calendar year during which same is issued and shall expire on the 1st. day of January next following the date of issuance. The Mayor shall have the right to revoke any such license for just cause. Any person or persons who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
