AN ORDINANCE NO. 1057.

Accepting deed of Louise Harris, Alice P. Sells and Stanley N. Sells for street purposes.

Whereas, Louise Harris, Alice P. Sells and Stanley N. Sells, her husband, have executed their certain deed to the Village of Bexley, Ohio, to be used for street purposes only, which said premises are described as follows, to-wit:-

Situate in the County of Franklin, State of Ohio, and Village of Bexley, and bounded and described as follows:-

Being in Half Section 21, Township 5, Range 22, Refugee Lands, and being a part of a two (2) acre tract conveyed by Anna Catherine Klupfel to Effie Herritt, by deed dated February 11, 1901, and of record in Deed Book 336, page 371, Recorder's Office, Franklin County; Ohio, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point located in the East line of said tract, fifty (50) feet North of the Southeast corner thereof; thence West parallel with the south line of said tract fifteen (15) feet to a point; thence North and parallel to the East line of said tract, one hundred eighty seven and five tenths (187.5) feet to a point in the South line of Fair Avenue as now established; thence Easterly and on a line parallel with the South line of Fair Avenue, fifteen (15) feet to a point; thence Southerly with the East line of said two (2) acre tract, one hundred eighty seven and five tenths (187.5) feet to the place of beginning.

And, whereas, the Council is of the opinion that it will be to the best interests of said Village to accept said deed, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of said Louise Harris, Alice P.Sells and Stanley N. Sells, bearing date of the 14th day of February,1930, conveying to the Village of Bexley the premises hereinabove described, the same to be used for street purposes only, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed the acceptance thereof by council, and to file the same for record in the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
