ORDINANCE NO. 1067.

To Amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1039 Levying special assessments for the improvement of Mound Street from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue, in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No.1039 providing for the levying of special assessments for the improvement of Mound Street from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, passed on the 11th day of February, 1930, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in nine annual installments, with interest at the rate of 4% per annum, from May 1st, 1930. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Chio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 2. That the Clerk shall certify a copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
