## ORDINANCE NO. 1070.

By Mr. Kerr.

Providing for the maintenance and repair of certain asphalt streets, roadsand avenues, in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That, whereas, the streets, roads and avenues in the Village of Bexley which have been paved with asphalt for more than five years, the maintenance guarantee of which have expired, are in need of repairs so that same may be maintained as proper highways, said streets, roads and avenues shall be repaired by patching, sealing the cracks and/or giving surface treatment, where same shall be determined to be necessary by the Street Commissioner and engineers, in accordance with the specifications and estimates thereof prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Clerk, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That such streets, roads and avenues, or parts thereof, so to be repaired shall be designated by the Street Commissioner and the engineers, and the work shall be some under their supervision.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the Village from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets,
Motor Vehicle License Fund and the Maintenance and Repair of Streets,
Gasoline Tax Fund.

Section 4. That the sum of \$10000.00 is hereby appropriated from said Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Motor Vehicle License Fund, and the sum of \$3000.00 is hereby appropriated from said Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Gasoline Tax Fund, for the purpose of paying the cost of said requirs.

Section F. Note the Cherk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to adventure for bids for the making of said repairs according to law.

Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be in emergency ordinance, and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, by reason of the fact that said streets are fast deteriorating and that places are becoming unsafe for traffic, and said ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
