

ORDINANCE NO. 1075.

Changing the name of Maryland Avenue, between Cassady Avenue and Stanwood Road to Delmar Drive.

Whereas, there are two avenues in the Village of Bexley bearing the name of Maryland Avenue, which fact leads to much confusion and inconvenience to the public, and

Whereas, the Avenue known as Maryland Avenue extending between Cassady Avenue and Stanwood Road, being the next avenue north of Allegheny Avenue, is practically an extension of Delmar Drive, and Council is satisfied that it would be to the interest of the public to change the name of said Avenue to Delmar Drive, that there is good cause for such change of name and that it will not be detrimental to the general interests and that such change should be made, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the name of Maryland Avenue, being the next avenue north of Allegheny Avenue and extending from Cassady Avenue to Stanwood Road, be and the same is hereby changed to Delmar Drive.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
