

ORDINANCE NO. 1079.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Main Street from the east end of Alum Creek bridge to the east line (produced south) of Parkview Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Main Street from the east end of Alum Creek bridge to the east line (produced south) of Parkview Avenue, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary sewers or drains to furnish proper drainage for said improvement, rebuilding of portions of the sidewalk and driveway entrances due to change of curb, changing the radius of the curb connection thereof with Parkview Avenue, and doing the necessary repaving connected therewith, in accordance with Resolution No. 857, adopted June 10th, 1930, declaring the necessity therefor, and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Clerk.

Provided, however, that portion of the roadway of said street between a line one (1) foot north of the north rail of the tracks of The Columbus Railway, Power & Light Company and a line one (1) foot south of the south rail of said tracks shall be improved by said The Columbus Railway, Power & Light Company and said portion of said street shall not be included in this proceeding.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement, and the Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said improvement, including the cost of intersections, together with the cost of any real estate or interest therein, purchased or appropriated, and the cost and expense of any appropriation proceeding therefor, and the damages awarded any owner of adjoining lands and interest thereon,

and the costs and expenses of any such award, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds in the manner provided by law.

Section 4. That the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
