ORDINANCE NO. 1084.

Providing for the maintenance and repair of intersections of Clifton Avenue with Parkview, Columbia and Drexel Avenues, in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Two thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That, whereas, the intersections of Clifton Avenue with Parkview, Columbia and Drexel Avenues by reason of the removal of the tracks of The Columbus Railway Power & Light Company have been left uneven and in a bad state of repair, and the same are in need of repairs so that said intersections may be maintained as proper highways, said intersections of said avenues shall be repaired by removing said tracks, moving the south curb of Clifton Avenue southwardly approximately four feet, constructing brick gutters and resurfacing said intersections in accordance with the specifications and estimates thereof prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Clerk, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the Village from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Motor Vehicle License Fund and the Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Gasoline Tax Fund.

Section 3. That the sum of \$1200.00 is hereby appropriated from said Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Gasoline Tax Fund, #14-appropriate for the purpose of paying the cost of said repairs.

Section 4. That the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the making of said repairs according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, by reason of the fact that said intersections have become unsafe for traffic, and said ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
