ORDINANCE NO. 1085.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Westland

Avenue between Park Hill Drive and a point ninety (90) feet south of
the south line of the property of Harriett H. Richards.

EE IT CRDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:
Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Westland Avenue between Park Hill Drive and a point ninety (90) feet south of the south line of the property of Harriett H. Richards, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein, with necessary hydrant, valve, etc., and making the necessary service connections, in accordance with Resolution No. 878, adopted on the 11th day of August, 1930, and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement, heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement, and the solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less onefiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be
assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said
improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: Being
all of the lots and lands fronting and abutting upon the west side of
Westland Avenue between the points hereinabove named, except the first
lot lying south of Park Hill Drive, which lots and lands are hereby
determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, in the
amount equal to that part of the cost of said improvement hereby
determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in nine annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessment in cash within thirty

days after the passage of the assessing ordinance.

Section 5. That bonds of the Village of Bexley, shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto; and notes of said Village shall be issued in anticipation of the issue of such bonds.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds of said Village issued in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. That the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
