AN ORDINANCE NO. 1087.

To amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1029 amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1001 creating the position and providing for the appointment of a forester in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1029 amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1001 creating the position and providing for the appointment of a forester in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, passed October 8th, 1929, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Said appointment shall be at the pleasure of the Mayor, but not to exceed one (1) year, and the salary shall not exceed \$250.00 per month during the term of service.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into immediate force and effect.
