

RESOLUTION NO. 825.

Declaring it necessary to improve Bryden Road from Remington Road to Gould Road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That **it** is necessary to improve Bryden Road from Remington Road to Gould Road, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary sewers or drains to furnish proper drainage for said improvement, constructing water lines and erecting street signs and making the necessary service connections, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement, heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Clerk, and which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the grade of said Bryden Road as improved shall be the grade shown by and upon the plans and profiles aforesaid, and the grade of the curbs shall be as follows, to-wit:

NORTH CURB:

Beginning at the east line of Remington Road, station 0+00, and elevation 110.80; thence easterly with a 0.66% descending grade to the center line of Roosevelt Avenue, station 5+85 and elevation 106.94; thence easterly with a 0.30% descending grade to the west line of Gould Road, station 14+02.4 and elevation 104.49.

SOUTH CURB:

The elevation of the south curb shall be the same as the elevation of the north curb.

Above elevations refer to Village Datum.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth ($1/50$) thereof, and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement, in the amount equal to that part of the cost of said improvement hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid

in nine annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessment in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessing ordinance.

Section 5. That the bonds of the Village of Bexley shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto; and notes of said Village shall be issued in anticipation of the issue of such bonds.

Section 6. That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement, not specially assessed, including the cost of intersections, and the damages awarded any owner of adjoining lands and interest thereon, and the costs and expenses of any such award, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
