RESOLUTION NO. 858.

Declaring it necessary to extend the intercepting sanitary sewer constructed without regard to sewer districts in Livingston Avenue to furnish an additional outlet for the sewers of Districts Nos.1,2,3,4, and 6, by constructing the remaining portion thereof as as to connect with the trunk sewer in the City of Columbus.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF ORIGO.

Section 1. That it is necessary to construct the following portion of the intercepting sanitary sewer in Livingston Avenue designed to furnish an additional outlet for the system of sewers heretofore adopted and installed in Districts Nos. 1,2,3,4, and 6 in said Village, the portion so to be constructed to begin at the west end of that portion of said sewer heretofore constructed in accordance with Resolution No. 784, adopted June 11th, 1929, declaring the necessity therefor, and pursuant to an Ordinance No. 1021, passed July 23, 1929, detarmining to proceed with said improvement, which said west end of said sower is at the east bank of Alum Creek, running thence westerly across Alum Creek a distance of approximately 287 feet to and connecting with the track sewer is the City of Columbus now under construction and designated as Sewerage & Sewege Disposal Contract No. 1, Alum Creek Intercepting Sewer, Section No. 1, according to the plans and specifications prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Clerk,

plans and apecifications so on file in the office of the Cherk, which are hereby approved, and shall be 30 inches in dimeter and shall be constructed of vitrified pipe, segment block, or concrete, or east iron pipe.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by the Village, and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of preliminary and other surveys, the printing and publishing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of such hotices, the cost of construction and all other necessary expenditures. Said cost shall be paid from the proceeds of

bonds of said Village issued in the manner provided by law, provided however, the notes of said Village may be issued and sold in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
