

RESOLUTION NO. 877.

Providing for sidewalks on Sherwood Road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That sidewalks shall be constructed on the south side of Sherwood Road in front of Lots Nos. 9, 10, 11 and 12, as shown of record on plat F of the partition of the Thomas Miller estate, Complete Record Volume 96, page 567, office of the clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, Franklin County, Ohio. Said sidewalks to be constructed of the character and in the manner following:-

Said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by Council and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk. Said sidewalks shall be five (5) feet in width, with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{8}$ ths of an inch per foot, and shall be placed with the inside edge one (1) foot from the property line. The grade of the inside edge, or the edge next to the lot line, shall be 6 inches above the curb, and parallel thereto.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

That the Clerk of Council be, and he is hereby, directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.
