

## RESOLUTION NO. 906.

Providing for the entering into of an agreement with the City of Columbus for fire protection from and after December, 31st, 1930.

Whereas, the contract of the Village of Bexley with the City of Columbus, Ohio, providing for fire protection to said Village will expire on the 31st day of December, 1930, and

Whereas, it is deemed to be for the best interests of said Village that a contract shall be entered into with said City of Columbus extending said service for a further period, NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the Mayor and Clerk of said Village be and hereby are authorized in the name of the Village to enter into an agreement with the City of Columbus for fire protection for the period beginning January 1st, 1931, and extending for such term as may be agreed upon and subject to substantially the terms and conditions contained in the present agreement with said City expiring December 31, 1930; and the proper officials are hereby authorized and directed to issue the vouchers of the Village for the amounts becoming due under said contract as the same shall respectively become due and payable.

Section 2. Whereas, the Village of Bexley, under the provisions of law, will be officially classified as a City from and after the first day of January, 1931, this contract, if entered into, subsequent to said date shall be executed in the name of the City of Bexley, and the obligations of said contract shall extend to and be binding for the full term thereof upon said municipality of Bexley, whether entered into prior or subsequent to said first day of January, 1931.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


