

ORDINANCE NO. 1-31

Providing for a President of Council.

Whereas, the municipality of Bexley on the 1st day of January, 1931, was advanced to the status of a city, as defined by the statutes, and it is provided by statute that the "officers of a Village advanced to a city * * * shall continue in office until succeeded by the proper officers of the new corporation at the next regular election," and

Whereas, the statutes relating to villages, the status which said municipality occupied, provide that the Mayor shall be President of Council, and no definite provision is made by the statutes to the contrary prior to the next general election after said village is advanced to the status of a city, and

Whereas, it is the desire of Council that the present Mayor shall continue to act in the capacity of President of Council until his successor is elected at the next regular election, NOW,


THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor shall be the President of Council until his successor shall be elected and qualified at the next general election.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
