

RESOLUTION NO. 2-31.

To provide for payment of damage to uniform of Officer C. D. Reed.

WHEREAS, police officer C. D. Reed, while engaged in fighting a fire within the City of Bexley and having been called out on an emergency run and not having time to secure a rain coat which was not in its proper place on the fire truck, sustained damage to his uniform by reason of having been sprayed with chemicals from fire extinguisher entailing total loss of said uniform, and

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that the claim of said officer for reimbursement for damages is a proper obligation of the city and that same should paid, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That officer C. D. Reed be re-imbursed in the amount of \$25.00 for damages to his uniform incurred as hereinabove set forth and that there be, and hereby is, appropriated from B-4 appropriation in the Safety Fund the sum of \$25.00 for the payment of same.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. Adopted January 27, 1931.
