

ORDINANCE NO. 10-31

By Mr. Bonnet.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Westland Avenue between Park Hill Drive and a point ninety (90) feet south of the south line of the property of Harriett H. Richards, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Westland Avenue between Park Hill Drive and a point ninety (90) feet south of the south line of the property of Harriett H. Richards, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein, pursuant to and in accordance with an Ordinance No. 1085, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed September 9th, 1930, in the aggregate amount of \$1120.00, as reported to this council on the 23rd day of December, 1930, by the board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of the filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:

Davis, Preston	1 acre	\$373.33
Doren, Jane N.	4.32 acres	373.34
Richards, Harriett	1 acre	373.33

And it is hereby determined and declared by this council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in nine annual installments, with interest thereon from the 1st day of March, 1931, at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same, to-wit, the

rate of _____ per centum per annum. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said City. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Notice of Assessments for Various Improvements in Bexley, Ohio.
Notice is hereby given that the estimated assessment of the cost of constructing a water line in Westland Avenue, between Park Hill Drive and a point 90 ft. south of the south line of Harriett H. Richards property; and of constructing water mains in Elm Avenue, from Roosevelt Avenue to Gould Road; Dale Avenue, from valve at east side of Stanwood Road to valve at west side of Roosevelt Avenue and from valve at east side of Roosevelt Avenue to valve at west side of Roosevelt Avenue; Merkle Road; Merkle Road from south line of Lot 15, Bexley Highlands Amended, to Elm Avenue; Fair Avenue, from Roosevelt Avenue to east line of Lot 15, Bexley Highlands Amended; Brentwood Road, from Remington Road to Gould Road; Shervood Road, from Remington Road to Gould Road; north side of Main Street, from Remington Road to Gould Road; Roosevelt Avenue, from approximately 48 ft. south of the north line of Main Street to the south line of Bryden Road and from the north line of Bryden Road to the south line of Bexley Park Road; and from the north line of Bexley Park Road to the valve at east side of Park Road to the valve at east side of water mains in Gould Road and portions of Main Street and Maryland Avenue, passing Bryden Road, from Drexel Avenue to Cassidy Road; paving Bexley Park Road, from Remington Road to Gould Road; constructing sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary District No. 5, between Main Street and Maryland Ave; and installing ornamental street lights on Astor Avenue, between College Avenue and Pleasant Ridge Avenue; on the lots and lands benefited and to be charged therewith, as set forth in resolutions providing for such construction, has been made and reported to the council and said estimated assessments are now on file in the office of the Clerk, Bexley, Ohio, for inspection and examination by all persons interested therein. Objections to said assessments shall be filed in writing with the clerk within the time prescribed by law.
