## RESOLUTION NO. 13-J1.

By Mr. F. Bonnet.

Declaring it necessary to improve the first alley south of Main Street from Euclaire Avenue to Montrose Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:
Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve the first alley south of Main Street from Euclaire Avenue to Montrose Avenue, in the City of Bexley, Ohio, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with concrete in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement, heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Clerk, and which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the grade of said alley as improved shall be the grade established by Ordinance No. 1096, passed on October 28, 1930, establishing the grade of said alley between Cassingham Road and Montrose Avenue, and Ordinance No. 33-31, passed March 23, 1931, establishing the grade of said alley from Euclaire Avenue to Cassingham Road.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one fiftieth (1/50) thereof, and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-witi- All of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement, in the amount equal to that part of the cost of said improvement hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in nine annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessment in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessing ordinance.

Section 5. That the bonds of the City of Bexley shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto; and notes of said City shall be issued in anticipation of the issue of such bonds.

Section 6. That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement, not specially assessed, including the cost of intersections, and the damages awarded any owner of adjoining lands and interest thereon, and the costs and expenses of any such award, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
