RESOLUTION NO. 16-31.

Authorizing the Eoard of Trustees of Public Affairs to enter into a contract for construction and extension of water line in the alley north of Havenwood Drive.

Whereas, Lots Nos. 98, 99, 100, 101 and 102 of Bexley Plaza Addition fronting on North Havenwood Drive are not served by the mains running to the east and west thereof, and the owners of said lots are about to improve the same, and have no water service, and such service can be given to said lots by constructing and extending a four (4) inch line in the alley north of said lots, and

water line as a part of any street improvement and assess the cost thereof against the benefitted properties, and whereas, said Board of Trueses of Public Affairs can have said water line built at a cost approximately \$375.00, and the property owners have expressed their willingness to pay one-half the cost thereof at such times as they shall respectively apply for water service, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CCUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs, through its President and Clerk, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with a responsible contractor, without first advertising for bids therefor, to construct and extend a four (4) inch water line in the alley at the rear of the above mentioned lots, between the existing valves located at Euclaire Avenue and Cassingham Road, and to pay the cost thereof out of the funds in its hands, and to apportion one-half of the cost thereof equitably against the said above mentioned lots, said amounts so apportioned against each of said lots to be paid at such time as the owner thereof shall make application for the use of water therefrom, such charges to bear interest at the rate of 5% per annum until paid. Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the engineers, and shall be made under the supervision of said engineers.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force

from and after the earliest to be allowed by law.
