

RESOLUTION NO. 23-31.

RESOLUTION OF MUNICIPALITY PROPOSING TO COOPERATE WITH THE DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, the public interest demands the improvement hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the council of the City of Bexley, State of Ohio, desires to cooperate with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, in accomplishing said improvement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the City of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the public interest demands the improvement, under the provisions of Section 1189 and related sections of the General Code of Ohio, of that part of State Highway No. 1, situated in the City of Bexley, county of Franklin, and State of Ohio, more particularly described as follows.

Beginning at the end of the present brick street in Main Street at the east line of Euclaire Avenue, and running thence east to the corporation line at the center of Gould Road as it runs north from Main Street, in all a distance of 2483 feet.

Section 2. That the council of the City of Bexley, State of Ohio, does hereby propose to cooperate with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, in the construction of the above described portion of State Highway No. 1, by assuming and contributing the entire cost of said improvement excepting therefrom the construction cost of a 20 ft. strip of said pavement, inclusive of engineering, preliminary contingencies and other incidental expenses.

Section 3. That this resolution be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
