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RESOLUTION NO. 2-32

Declaring it to be expedient and necessary to construct a main drain or storm sewer in the north side of Broad Street from the existing manhole about 600 feet east of Alum Creek to the storm sewer at Stanbery Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is deemed expedient and necessary to construct a main drain or sewer in the north side of Broad Street from the existing manhole about 600 feet east of Alum Creek to the storm sewer at Stanbery Avenue, for the purpose of furnishing surface and storm drainage to the territory contiguous thereto, without previously adopting any plan of sewerage or division of territory into storm sewer districts.

Section 2. That said sewer or drain shall be constructed in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for the proposed improvement prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Auditor, which said plans, specifications, estimates and profiles are hereby approved, and said sewer or drain shall be of concrete pipe, concrete monolithic, or segment block.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said improvement and damages awarded to any owner of adjoining lands, and the costs and expenses of any such award, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds in the manner provided by law, and notes may be issued in anticipation of the issuance of such bonds. The costs of said improvement shall include also the expense of the preliminary and other surveys, the serving of said notices, the cost of construction and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 4. It is hereby recited and declared that said improvement is conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare.

Section 5. This resolution is an emergency resolution, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that proceedings are pending for the improvement of Broad Street by the State of Ohio, and it will be necessary that said sewer be immediately constructed in advance of said improvement, and the same shall go into immediate effect.

RESOLUTION NO. 2-32.

Declaring it to be expedient and necessary to construct a main drain or storm sewer in the north side of Broad Street from the existing manholes about 600 feet east of Alum Creek to the storm sewer at Stanbery Avenue.  
Be it resolved by the council of the city of Bexley, state of Ohio: Three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring:  
Section 1—That it is deemed expedient and necessary to construct a main drain or sewer in the north side of Broad Street from the existing manhole about 600 feet east of Alum Creek to the storm sewer at Stanbery Avenue, for the purpose of furnishing surface and storm drainage to the territory contiguous thereto, without previously adopting any plan of sewerage or division of territory into storm sewer districts.  
Section 2—That said sewer or drain shall be constructed in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for the proposed improvement prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the auditor, which said plans, specifications, estimates and profiles are hereby approved, and said sewer or drain shall be of concrete pipe, concrete monolithic, or segment block.  
Section 3—That the entire cost of said improvement and damages to any owner of adjoining lands, and the costs and expenses of any such award, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds in the manner provided by law, and notes may be issued in anticipation of the issuance of such bonds. The costs of said improvement shall include also the expense of the preliminary and other surveys, the printing and publishing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of said notices, the cost of construction and all other necessary expenditures.  
Section 4—It is hereby recited and declared that said improvement is conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare.  
Section 5—This resolution is an emergency resolution, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that proceedings are pending for the improvement of Broad Street by the state of Ohio, and it will be necessary that said sewer be immediately constructed in advance of said improvement, and the same shall go into immediate effect.
