RESOLUTION OF MUNICIPALITY PROPOSING TO COOPERATE WITH THE DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, the public interest demands the improvement hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the council of the City of Bexley, State of Ohio, desires to cooperate with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, in accomplishing said improvement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the public interest demands the improvement, under the provisions of Section 1189 and related sections of the General Code of Ohio, of that part of State Highway No. 47, situated in the City of Bexley, county of Franklin, and State of Ohio, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the east end of the bridge over Alum Creek, and running thence east to the east corporation line of said City, and being that portion of said highway lying within the corporate limits of said City of Bexley.

in all a distance of about one mile.

Section 2. That the council of theCity of Bexley, State of Ohio, does hereby propose to cooperate with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, in the Construction of the above described portion of State Highway No. 47, by assuming and contributing the entire cost, except the construction cost of a twenty foot roadway, including the grading and necessary drainage, inclusive of engineering, preliminary contingencies and other includental expenses.

Section 3. That this resolution be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
