RESOLUTION NO. 16-32

Authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, for the confinement of prisoners.

Whereas, the City of Bexley is not provided with a workhouse or other jail wherein to confine persons convicted of the violation of ordinances of said city and it is desirable to enter into a contract with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio for said purpose, as provided in Section 4564 et seq. of the General Code, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESCLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the City of Bexley to enter into a contract with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, for the use of the jail of said County for the imprisonment of persons convicted of the violation of an ordinance or ordinances of said City of Bexley from and after the first day of April, 1932, until said contract is terminated in the manner provided by law, therein agreeing to pay to said Board of County Commissioners for every person so confined all expenses during said confinement, including a charge of forty-five (45¢) cents per day, "subject to the rules, regulations and discipline of said County jail, the same as other persons as are therein confined, and containing such other reasonable rules and regulations as may be provided by law or required by said Board of County Commissioners, and as shall be approved by the City Solicitor. Said charge for the confinement of said prisoners shall be paid from 2010 approposation is the Safety fund.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
