

RESOLUTION NO. 18-32

Providing for approval and confirmation of acceptance of bid for bond issue for the purpose of paying for the cost of constructing a main trunk storm sewer extension from the south end of the existing main trunk storm sewer at Station 11+57.6 of Sewer Survey southwesterly to the north end of the culvert under Livingston Avenue.

RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the acceptance of the bid of Banc-Ohio Securities Company for the bonds of the City of Bexley in the sum of \$10,850.00 issued for the purpose of paying for the cost of constructing a main trunk storm sewer extension from the south end of the existing main trunk storm sewer at Station 11+57.6 of Sewer Survey southwesterly to the north end of the culvert under Livingston Avenue and under issued under authority of Ordinance No. 22-32, passed April 12, 1932, which bid is the par value of said bonds, together with accrued interest and a premium of \$19.80, and based upon a rate of interest at the rate of 6%, said rate being other than that provided for in said ordinance providing for such issue, be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed.

Section 2. That the Auditor be and he hereby is directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
