

RESOLUTION No. 28-32

Appropriating the proceeds of bond issue to payment of notes heretofore issued for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing a main drain or storm sewer in the north side of Broad Street from the existing manhole about 600 feet east of Alum Creek to the Storm Sewer at Stanbery Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Be it resolved that from the proceeds of the sale of bonds heretofore authorized under Ordinance No. 31-32, passed May 24, 1932, there be and is hereby appropriated to the Sinking Fund the sum of \$ 20,550⁰⁰ for the purpose of paying the outstanding notes, with interest, which were heretofore issued under authority of Ordinance No. 13-32, passed February 9, 1932, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the purpose of constructing a main drain or storm sewer in the north side of Broad Street from the existing manhole about 600 feet east of Alum Creek to the storm sewer at Stanbery Avenue, and the Auditor is hereby directed to transfer such amount of said proceeds for this purpose.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
