
Appropriating the proceeds of bond issue to payment of notes heretofore issued for the purpose of paying the cost of improving Main Street (being State Route No. 1) from the east line of Euclaire Avenue to Gould Road.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Be it resolved that from the proceeds of the sale of bonds heretofore authorized under Ordinance No. 49-32, passed September 13, 1932, there be and is hereby appropriated to the Sinking Fund the sum of \$24,260.00 for the purpose of paying the outstanding notes, with interest, which were heretofore issued under authority of Ordinance No. 59-31, passed July 16, 1931, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the purpose of improving Main Street (being State Route No. 1) from the east line of Euclaire Avenue to Gould Road, and the Auditor is hereby directed to transfer such amount of said proceeds for this purpose.


Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
