

ORDINANCE NO. 39-32

By Mr. Wheaton.

Amending Section 4 of Ordinance No. 25-32, providing for the issuance of notes of the City of Bexley, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the improvement of Broad Street from the east end of the bridge over Alum Creek to the East corporation line, as amended by Ordinance No. 26-32, passed May 9th, 1932, and by Ordinance No. 32-32, passed June 1st, 1932, and by Ordinance No. 33-32, passed June 1st, 1932.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 25-32, providing for the issuance of notes of the City of Bexley, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the purpose of paying the municipality's portion of the cost, and in anticipation of the levy of special assessments and in anticipation of the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection of special assessments, for the improvement of Broad Street, (being State Highway No. 47) from the east end of the bridge over Alum Creek to the east corporation line, and being that portion of said street lying within the corporate limits of said City, which improvement is being made in cooperation with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, as amended by Ordinance No. 26-32, passed May 9th, 1932, and by Ordinance No. 32-32, passed June 1st, 1932, and by Ordinance No. 33-32, passed June 1st, 1932, be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That such anticipatory notes in the amount of \$109,000.00, which sum does not exceed the amount of the bond issue, shall be issued bearing interest at the rate of 6% per

annum, payable semi-annually. Such notes shall be dated approximately the first day of June, 1932, and shall mature two years after date thereof, provided, however, said notes shall be redeemable at any interest paying period prior to maturity. Such notes shall be executed and delivered in such number and such denominations as may be requested by the purchaser of such notes.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, said emergency being that the present pavement of said street carries an excessive crown and the same is so narrow as to cause a congestion of traffic dangerous to the public, and that it is necessary to remove said danger without unnecessary delay, and that said work be proceeded with at once that same may be completed before the winter season. Wherefore, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
