

ORDINANCE NO. 48-32

By Mr. D. W. Kerr.

Providing for repairing and maintaining Cassady Road, from Broad Street to Ruhl Avenue, by constructing adequate drainage therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Cassady Road, from Broad Street to Ruhl Avenue, shall be repaired and the maintenance thereof provided for by constructing therein a vitrified pipe drain with inlets, man-holes and other necessary appurtenances to furnish adequate drainage for said street between said points, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement, heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Mayor, and which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement, and the solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said repairs and improvement shall be paid by the City of Bexley from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Motor Vehicle License Fund.

Section 4. That the sum of \$4,500.00 is hereby appropriated from said Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Motor Vehicle License Fund, for the purpose of paying the cost of said repairs and improvement.

Section 5. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make and execute a contract for said improvement with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement, according to law.

Section 6. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and welfare, said emergency being that it is necessary to make said repairs and improvement before the winter season, and said ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
