

ORDINANCE NO. 55-32

By Mr. Wheaton.

To provide location of sidewalks on Cassingham Road from Denver Avenue to Maryland Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That when sidewalks are constructed on either or both sides of Cassingham Road from the north side of Denver Avenue to the south line of Maryland Avenue, said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by council, and now on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.

Section 2. The near edge of the sidewalk shall be placed 10 feet from the back edge of the curb and the far edge of the sidewalk 14-1/2 ft. from the back of the curb, and that such far edge shall be located 6 inches above the top of the curb, and that the sidewalk shall have a slope towards the curb of 3/8 inch per foot. The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
