

ORDINANCE NO. 56-32

By Mr. Pretzman.

Authorizing the provisional appointment of police officer.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to appoint a provisional police officer under provisions of Section 486-14 of the General Code to fill a vacancy now existing in the police department, and that the salary of said appointee be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$125.00 per month.

Section 2. An emergency exists in said police department in that there are not sufficient officers to properly carry on the work of the department, wherefore, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
