

RESOLUTION NO. 3-33

By Mr. Wheaton.

Granting permission to The Ohio Bell Telephone Company and The Columbus Railway, Power & Light Company to relocate poles on Clifton Avenue between Drexel Avenue and Parkview Avenue.

Whereas, The Ohio Bell Telephone Company has requested permission to trim the trees on the south side of Clifton Avenue between Drexel and Parkview Avenues to prevent interference with the wires belonging to said Company and The Columbus Railway, Power & Light Company, and

Whereas, if the poles whereon said wires are strung should be moved near the curb line of said street it will be unnecessary to injure and deform said trees by trimming, and council is of the opinion that the poles should be so relocated so as to preserve said trees in their natural beauty, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted to The Ohio Bell Telephone Company and The Columbus, Railway, Power & Light Company to move the poles located between Drexel and Parkview Avenues on the south side of Clifton Avenue to a line near the south curb line of said Clifton Avenue, the locations for which shall be furnished by the engineers and shall be such as will not interfere with any underground service of the municipality.

Section 2. That the Clerk by writing notify each of the above named companies of the passage of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
