

ORDINANCE NO. 8-33

To provide for purchasing the necessary material to construct a 4 inch water main in Astor Avenue from Sheridan Avenue to a point 240 feet westerly therefrom.

Whereas, Daniel P. Bailey is the owner of a 50 foot tract of land fronting on the north side of Astor Avenue beginning 205 feet westerly from the west line of Sheridan Avenue, upon which premises he has constructed a dwelling house, and

Whereas, there is at this time no water main in Astor Avenue for the service of said premises, and the said Daniel P. Bailey has offered to furnish the necessary labor for installing a 4 inch water main in Astor Avenue from Sheridan Avenue past his said premises without cost to the municipality, on condition that the municipality will furnish the necessary materials therefor, and

Whereas, the engineers have estimated that the materials therefor will consist of one 4-inch 1/16 bend, one 6" x 4" reducer and twenty pieces of 4" x 12' cast iron pipe, together with lead jute, which materials will cost \$170.00, and have estimated the engineering costs at \$25.00, and

Whereas, Council is of the opinion that said proposal should be accepted, and said municipality should furnish said materials therefor, and the said Daniel P. Bailey authorized to construct said water main without cost to the municipality, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to purchase the necessary materials for constructing said water main from the stub now in the west line of Sheridan Avenue at the intersection of Astor Avenue westerly in Astor Avenue for a distance of 240 feet, said materials consisting of one 4-inch bend, one 6"x4" reducer and twenty pieces of 4"x12' cast iron pipe, together with lead jute; that said Daniel P. Bailey is hereby authorized

under the supervision of the engineers and the Superintendent of the Department of Water, to install said pipe, without cost to the municipality, the same when installed to be and remain the property of the City of Bexley, and to be subject to be used by other property owners, all in accordance with the plans heretofore prepared by the engineers.

Section 2. That the sum of \$195.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund for the payment of the purchase price of said materials and engineering costs.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
