

ORDINANCE NO. 12-33

By Mr. Wheaton.

Authorizing the construction of a sanitary relief sewer in the alley north of Broad Street from Cassady Road east to the first alley east thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to contract for and construct a sanitary relief sewer in the first alley north of Broad Street from Cassady Road east to the first alley east of Cassady Road, being a distance of 192 feet, in accordance with the plans and estimates of the engineers now on file with the Mayor; said contract to include the furnishing of all materials and labor therefor except eighty (80) hours of labor, which labor shall be furnished by the municipality.

Section 2. That the sum of \$291.84 be and hereby is appropriated for the payment of said contract from the General Sanitary Sewer Bond Fund and that said labor be paid for from the Service Fund, and the engineering services in the sum of \$35.00 be paid out of the Engineering Fund, which amount is hereby appropriated for that purpose.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and health, and shall go into immediate effect.
