RESOLUTION NO. 13-33.

Appointing a Board to report estimated assessments to pay the cost and expense of improving broad Street from the east end of the bridge over Alum Creek to the east corporation line of the City of Bexley.

Whereas, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost, less the cost of that portion agreed to be paid by the State of Ohio, and less 35% of the remaining cost (which 35% includes more than one-fiftieth (1/50th) of the remaining cost, and the cost of intersections) of the improvement of Broad Street from the east corporation line, in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That Charles Lynas, C. B. Hays and Grover L. Orr, three disinterested free-holders of said city, be and they are hereby appointed a hoard to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set forth in Ordinance No. 36-32, to improve said street, passed June 14, 1932, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots and parcels of land so assessed, and to report to this council the said estimated assessment.

That all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
