

ORDINANCE NO. 17-33

Employing the Jennings-Lawrence Company to prepare and furnish necessary data for use in trial of damage cases growing out of alleged pollution of Alum Creek.


Whereas, a number of cases have been filed against the City of Bexley for damages growing out of the alleged pollution of Alum Creek, and for the purpose of preparing the necessary defense thereto it will be necessary that certain evidence be prepared by the engineers, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Jennings-Lawrence Company be and they are hereby employed to prepare and furnish such evidence as may be required by the City Solicitor in the preparation and trial of said damage cases.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
