ORDINANCE NO. 29-33

By Mr. F. H. Bonnet.

Providing for the maintenance and repair of certain asphalt streets, roads and avenues, in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That, whereas, Cassady Road from Brentwood Road to Broad Street; Ardmore Road from Fair Avenue to Broad Street, and Cassingham Road from Elm Avenue to Broad Street, are in need of repairs, so that the same may be maintained as proper highways; said streets, roads and avenues between said points shall be repaired by patching, sealing the cracks, and/or giving surface treatment, in accordance with the specifications and estimates thereof prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the City from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Motor Vehicle License Fund, and the sum of \$3250.00 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying the cost of said repairs.

Section 3. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the making of said repairs according to law.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, by reason of the fact that said streets are fast deteriorating and that places are recoming unsafe for traffic, and said ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
