ORDINANCE NO. 22-33

By Mr. C. L. Crippen.

Providing for purchase of two traffic "stop signals".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to purchase and install two traffic "stop-signals", same to be installed at such street intersections as he may deem most necessary and expedient, and to cost not to exceed \$104.00, completely installed.

Section 2. That the sum of \$104.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair, Gasoline Tax Fund for the purchase thereof.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
