ORDINANCE NO. 23-33

By Mr. C. L. Crippen.

Providing for redressing curbing for use on Mound Street, between College and Sheridan Avenues.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to employ B. F. Patterson, Contractor, in accordance with his proposal, to redress the curbing to be used on Mound Street, between College Avenue and Sheridan Avenue, at a cost of not to exceed twenty-five cents per lineal foot, said curbing to be delivered upon said street.

Section 2. That the sum of \$250.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair (Motor Vehicle License) Fund, for the payment of the cost thereof.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
