

ORDINANCE NO. 24-33

By Mr. Pretzman.

Providing for the insurance of the motor vehicles of the police and service departments against liability for injury and property damage.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to procure insurance against liability for bodily injury to the extent of \$10,000.00 for each person, with limit of \$20,000.00 on each accident, and property damage liability in the sum of \$5,000.00 for each accident, said insurance to be procured of a reliable insurance company at a cost not to exceed \$490.06, said amount being the best rate which the Safety Committee has been able to obtain after thorough investigation.

Section 2. That the sum of \$490.06 be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the payment of said insurance.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that an additional liability has been placed upon municipalities by recent enactment of the Legislature of the State of Ohio, making it necessary that said insurance be provided, for which reason said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
