

ORDINANCE NO. 25-33

By Mr. Klingbeil.

Authorizing contract for hauling and filling in topsoil on Broad Street at Drexel Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to enter into a contract for the hauling of top-soil from the lands belonging to the City of Bexley located south of Livingston Avenue, formerly used for sewage disposal plant, and deposit of same in that part of Broad Street constituting the circle at Drexel Avenue at such places as the Superintendent of Streets may direct, at a total cost of not to exceed \$500.00. Said work to be under the direction of the Superintendent of Streets.

Section 2. That the sum of \$500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair, Gasoline Tax Fund.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the time for seeding the space so to be top-dressed will require that said work be done immediately, for which reason this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
